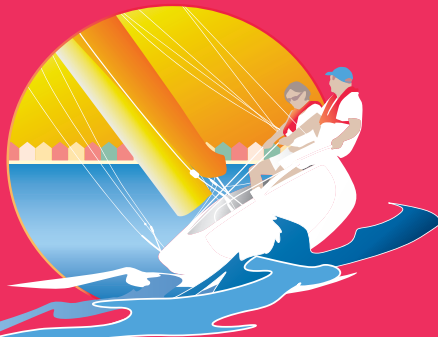

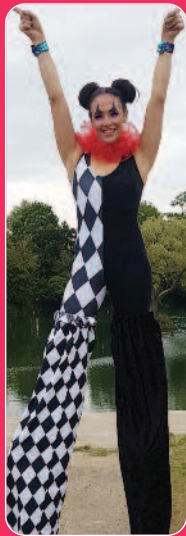

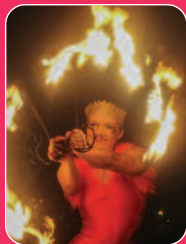

Add to that an exciting RNLI rescue demonstration in the harbour plus historic vessels on show and a wonderful firework display; more ambitious than any that's gone before!

It will all be happening throughout the harbour, Waterside, Marina and Western Promenade over the weekend of 20-21 July. With the host of shoreside and waterborne activities listed in this leaflet, there is a plentiful variety to entertain the whole family - everything from try sailing (adults and kids), power boating, paddle boarding, gig rowing and opportunities to go onboard historic vessels if you are feeling energetic.



Of course, if you would rather sit back and relax, all of the clubs and harbour cafés and restaurants will be open to the public where you can watch other activities such as duck racing, dinghy, yacht and gig racing as well as the sandcastle and crabbing competitions. Visit stalls lining the regatta trail, watch street entertainment, listen to live music, enjoy a beach party on the Saturday night, spoil yourself and the kids with bbqs and children's entertainment so there will be something for everyone.



There will be the raft race in support of St Helena Hospice to be held off the Western Promenade on Saturday afternoon, open to teams from pubs, clubs, companies, organisations and groups of friends.

Take a walk down the Town Jetty to look over the James Stevens Lifeboat (RNLI) built 1894, an RNLI Operational lifeboat, an Essex Marine Police RIB and WW2 Motor Torpedo Boat 102. Built 1939.

Organised by the harbour Office, an exciting display of the RNLI attending a yacht on fire, taking place on Saturday at 4.30pm in the harbour.
